PICTURA GRAPHICS CERTIFIED AS SUSTAINABLE GREEN PRINTER

Pictura Graphics hopes to lead the printing and graphic communications industry in increasing environmental stewardship.

MINNEAPOLIS – August 18: Digital graphics company Pictura Graphics (Pictura) has been named as a nationally certified “Sustainable Green Printer.” The SGP is the first and only national certification for printers that have implemented environmentally sustainable business practices. Nearly 40 companies offered their facilities to the SGP for evaluation, but only 11 were selected as a beta test site. Of the companies in the beta test group, Pictura Graphics earned the honor of achieving certification by the SGP.

“Pictura Graphics believes that sustainability is an integral business practice. We strive to achieve continuous improvements in all areas of environmental stewardship within the visual communications industry,” stated Paul Lilienthal, President of Pictura.

As part of its commitment to sustainability, Pictura Graphics recently launched its ealIMAGES™ line, featuring products that are recyclable, biodegradable, and that use inks that are volatile organic compound (VOC) free. Pictura’s dedication to environmental responsibility has also earned them designation in the Printing Industry of Minnesota’s “Great Printer Environmental Initiative.” Pictura has identified additional opportunities to improve its environmental stewardship in the categories of air, waste, water, energy and natural resources.

“We are proud to announce the certification of Pictura as a Sustainable Green Printer under the SGP Partnership,” stated Marcia Y. Kinter, Vice President of Government and Business Information at Specialty Graphic Imaging Association, a founding partner of the SGP. “The stakeholders and founding partners have worked diligently to produce a set of criteria that will encourage the print and graphic communications industry to reduce its environmental impact and increase social responsibility.”

The project goals of the SGP are to define sustainable green printing and identify steps that will help the printing industry establish manufacturing practices and products that are more environmentally sustainable. The SGP’s certification process evaluates printers based on the following criteria:

- The Product – input materials used to produce a products such as substrates, inks and coatings
- The Process – the manufacturing process involving press equipment and supporting technology
- The Envelope – the building, energy consumption, employees and supporting activities

“It is Pictura’s mission to take the lead in exemplifying environmental responsibility through innovative product technologies and resources that provide sustainable results for our clients” said Lilienthal. “It is an honor for Pictura Graphics to be named a Sustainable Green Printer.”
